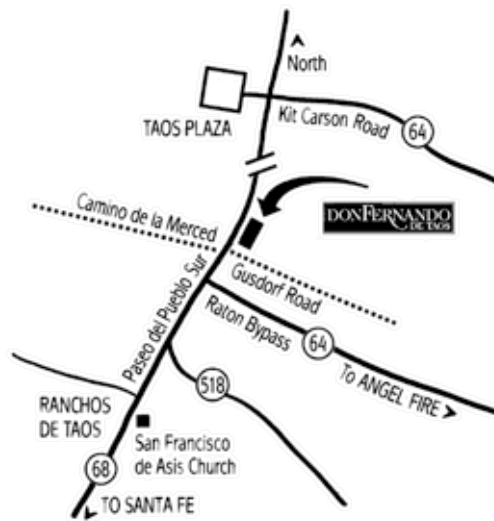

\$59/room/night + tax Room rates are for 2 Doubles or 1 King. Use “Southwest Ski & Snowboard Club” as the code when you make reservations to get the discounted rate. They are holding a block of rooms for us until January 16, 2009. After January 16, 2009 reservations will be accepted on a space available basis. Room rates are available from February 16th through February 19th. Before or after those dates rates are \$99.00/room/night+tax. Cancellations must be made 72 hours or more prior to arrival; if not, a charge of one night’s room and tax will apply.

There are all sorts of amenities including a lounge with free hors d’oeuvres and drink specials during happy hour, a hot tub and atrium pool and are close to transportation to the mountain. They are one mile from Historic Taos Plaza. www.donfernandodetaos.com

Ground Transfers

There is a shuttle, the Chili Run that runs from the Ski Valley to town about every thirty minutes. It picks up very close to the Don Fernando, if not right there. The link is on the Taos Ski Valley web site, http://www.skitaos.org/contents/view/getting_here

Driving Directions

From Albuquerque: I-25 to Santa Fe; exit on 599 N to by-pass Santa Fe; take Hwy 285 to Hwy 68 to Taos. It is approximately 135 miles, and 2 ½ hours.
